FOR COURSES OTHER THAN HEALTH:

Please contact your counselor for more information about the district's in-seat summer school. Counselor approval is required for online options. If the class is approved by your counselor, fill out the course title and semester prior to submitting the Online Summer School Application. Application will not be processed until your counselor approves the course. Registration for online summer school classes begins on Monday, March 21, 2022 at 5PM Applications due Friday, April 22, 2022

- <u>**REGISTRATION**</u>: Instructions are available at **https://www.mvla.net/as/hsd/summer** and with counseling staff at MVHS, LAHS & AVHS
- <u>ENROLLMENT</u>: Students <u>must submit an online application</u> and <u>register</u> no later than <u>Friday April 22</u> (NOTE: Placement will be prioritized by grade level and date of submission. JUNIORS AND SENIORS WILL BE GIVEN PRIORITY PLACEMENT)
- **<u>CONFIRMATION</u>**: Confirmed registration, class assignment and orientation reminder will be **e-mailed to the address** associated with your online registration account.
- <u>ELIGIBILITY</u>: Only MVLA District students who attend school <u>during the school year</u> are eligible to enroll in the district's *online* summer school program (Incoming freshman from 8th grade are NOT eligible to enroll.)
- **PROGRAM MODEL:** Online summer school is self-paced. Students can drop-in for help and testing (at their convenience) at the Adult School Room 104. **Summer Lab hours: Monday-Friday, 9 am to 4 pm.**
- **<u>REQUIREMENTS</u>**: In order to receive credit, *ALL* enrolled students are required to attend orientation, make regular progress in their coursework, <u>AND take course exams in person at the Adult School Room 104</u>. <u>Summer school is a privilege</u>; therefore, students who violate district or Adult School rules will be dropped from summer school, receive no credit for work completed, and be susceptible to administrative consequences.
